**Description**: Breakout Vice Recall

#### Discussion

What-if study of the existing Breakout Vise Type 1 (Tesco p/n 450034-1) recommended re-design of this equipment. Originally the tool was designed only for the downhole tools. The conclusion from the study is that the existing unit can be used in an unsafe manner. Following this conclusion a committee was established to revisit the use of the Vise Type 1. The committee included Tesco employees from Engineering, Operation, Management, and Manufacturing.

The main concern is use of the Vise for the making and breaking connections on the Casing Drive Tool which has a very large diameter. The trolley stand assembly is not designed for the outside diameter, weight, and safe handling of the tool.

Another reason for recommending a re-design is the Vise transportation issue. The existing design does not provide a safe way for transport and securing all the parts during the transport.

The new Breakout Vise Type 2 is designed to overcome the mentioned safety issues and all the other issues recognized during the What-if analysis of the Vise Type 1, and during the committee meetings.

A new What-if study is done for the Breakout Vise Type 2 (Tesco p/n 489026). The Vise Type 1 is discontinued, and all the new builds will be The Vise Type 2.

## **Models Affected**

Breakout Vise Type 1 (Tesco p/n 450034-1)

#### **Action Required**

Replace all the Type 1 Vise with the Type 2 Vise Assembly. The Tong, Vise, and HPU from the Type 1 could be used for upgrade to Type 2. Engineering will provide a kit for upgrade to Type 2 Vise.
